The high quality parkland Par 70 course measures over 6,300 yards from the back tees. The design of the course has stood the test of time and offers a good challenge to all levels of ability, from novice through to the foremost Sussex club and tour professionals.

The Clubhouse

Ifield Golf & Country Club is set in very attractive rural surroundings. The welcoming and comfortable Clubhouse incorporates both member and visitor locker rooms, a well-stocked Pro-Shop, a fully-licensed Member's Bar, a Snooker Room, a Spike Bar as well as an extensive Restaurant and catering facilities. The view from the Clubhouse conservatory provides panoramic views of the parkland course and the patio makes a great place to sit on a summers evening where, with luck, you can catch sight of the deer who are resident on the course.
